FEMS Microbiology Ecology invites submissions for a special thematic issue on the ecology of microbes in cold environments to coincide with the 4th International Conference on Polar and Alpine Microbiology which will be held September 4-8, 2011 in Ljubljana, Slovenia.

Topics of interest include: Ecology of cold terrestrial, cold aquatic and cold glacial environments; Permafrost; Microbial diversity of polar and alpine environments; Adaptions and physiology of cold adapted microorganisms; Evolution and phylogeny in cold environments; Bioremediation in cold environments; Climate change and consequences for life at the poles and in the mountains; Cold man-made environments; and Cryobiology and astrobiology.

All submitted papers should be complete in themselves and adequately supported by experimental detail; they should not be preliminary versions of communications to be published elsewhere. Prospective authors for MiniReviews should contact the Editors in advance. All manuscripts will undergo regular review by members of the Editorial Board and other appropriate experts.

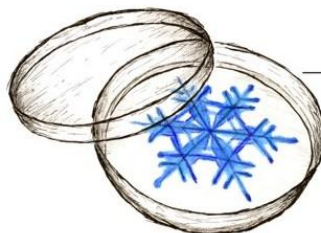
